



2006 Clay County Child Care Data Highlights

- 86.5% of families had all the parents in the household working
- Cost of one infant and one preschooler in family child care represents 17.4% of the median family income; 18.0% in a center
- Family child care homes comprise 87.2% of facilities and have 69.2% of the capacity
- 11.3% of the children referred were from families receiving SRS subsidies

2008 Clay County Census Facts

- Population = 8,859, this is a .4% growth from April 2000
- 21.5% of the population are under 18 years of age
- 6.2% of the population are under 5 years of age
- Median household income in 2007 was \$42,035
- 9.5% of the population are living below poverty (2007)

Kansas Facts of Interest as of 2009

- There are 152,967 Single parent households in Kansas
- 97,808 families with both parents in the household, still have both parents working outside the home
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time child care center arraignment = \$9,139
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time family child care home arraignment = \$6,012
- Average annual tuition and fees paid for a 4-year state college = \$6,141
- Number of child care workers in Kansas, 5,620
- Average income for full-time, year round child care provider - \$17,210
