2006 Lincoln County Child Care Data Highlights

- 13.6% of children referred were from families receiving SRS subsidies
- 15.2% of children age 0-17 are living in poverty
- Cost of one infant and one preschooler in family child care represents 19.3% of the median family income
- Family child care homes comprise 100% of the regulated facilities

2008 Lincoln County Census Facts

- Population = 3,261, this is a 8.9% decrease from April 2000
- 19.8% of the population are under 18 years of age
- 5.2% of the population are under 5 years of age
- Median household income in 2007 was \$36,490
- 11.2% of the population are living below poverty (2007)

Kansas Facts of Interest as of 2009

- There are 152,967 Single parent households in Kansas
- 97,808 families with both parents in the household, still have both parents working outside the home
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time child care center arraignment = \$9,139
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time family child care home arraignment = \$6,012
- Average annual tuition and fees paid for a 4-year state college = \$6,141
- Number of child care workers in Kansas, 5,620
- Average income for full-time, year round child care provider - \$17,210
