2006 Riley County Child Care Data Highlights

- Cost of one infant and one preschooler in family child care represents 17.4% of the median family income; 25.8% in a child care center
- 35.4% of the children referred were from families receiving SRS subsidies
- 12.7% of children age 0-17 are living in poverty
- 56.9% of families had all parents in the household working

2008 Riley County Census Facts

- Population = 71,069, this is a 12.9% increase from April 2000
- 20.6% of the population are under 18 years of age
- 6.9% of the population are under 5 years of age
- Median household income in 2007 was \$38,864
- 19% of the population are living below poverty (2007)

Kansas Facts of Interest as of 2009

- There are 152,967 Single parent households in Kansas
- 97,808 families with both parents in the household, still have both parents working outside the home
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time child care center arraignment = \$9,139
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time family child care home arraignment = \$6,012
- Average annual tuition and fees paid for a 4-year state college = \$6,141
- Number of child care workers in Kansas, 5,620
- Average income for full-time, year round child care provider - \$17,210
