2006 Saline County Child Care Data Highlights

- 21.1% of households with children under age 18 are headed by females
- Cost of one infant and one preschooler in family child care represents 17.3% of the median family income; 19.2% in a child care center
- Child care centers comprise 9.1% of the facilities and have 29.2% of the capacity
- 54.4% of the children referred were from families receiving SRS subsidy
- 44.8% of the children referred needed care during alternative hours

2008 Saline County Census Facts

- Population = 54,657, this is a 2% growth from April 2000
- 24.5% of the population are under 18 years of age
- 7.1% of the population are under 5 years of age
- Median household income in 2007 was \$42,557
- 10% of the population are living below poverty (2007)

Kansas Facts of Interest as of 2009

- There are 152,967 Single parent households in Kansas
- 97,808 families with both parents in the household, still have both parents working outside the home
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time child care center arraignment = \$9,139
- Average annual fees paid for an infant in a full time family child care home arraignment = \$6,012
- Average annual tuition and fees paid for a 4-year state college = \$6,141
- Number of child care workers in Kansas, 5,620
- Average income for full-time, year round child care provider - \$17,210
